- The significance of EVs was highlighted in a recent study by Experian Automotive stating that combined market share for BEVs and PHEVs in San Diego County was well above average compared to the other markets so far in 2023. BEV share in the county was 22.4% and PHEV share was 3.5%.
- Virtually every manufacturer at the show will feature some level of discussion about next gen vehicles at their exhibits.
- Advances in automotive safety technology will be featured and demonstrated by brand product specialists, eager to provide explanations.

- Known for its family-friendly atmosphere, entertaining features, and interactivity, the San Diego International Auto Show delights the entire family.
